Vincenzo Vignieri is an Assistant Professor at the Department of Law and Business Studies, University of Siena (Italy), where he teaches Business Administration. Formerly, he served as an Adjunct Professor in Business and Public Management at the Department of Political Sciences and International Relations, University of Palermo (Italy), where he taught Business Administration, Business Performance Analysis, and Performance Management in programs at master and doctoral level. He holds a Ph.D. in Public Management and Governance from the University of Palermo.
